The value and importance of mounting and protection kits

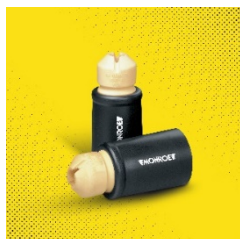
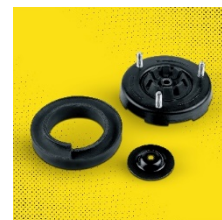
