ELIGIBILITY

Individuals who meet the following criteria are eligible for the Federal-Mogul Motorparts Automotive Technician Scholarship. The individuals must:

- at the time of application be (i) enrolled full-time at a US high school; or (ii) accepted or currently enrolled, either full-time or part-time, at an accredited college, university or trade school within the US. Trade school should be the equivalent of a two-year associate program.
- be in pursuit of an automotive technician degree or certification (or equivalent degree/certification).
- carry a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- be a legal resident of the United States, in the United States on a student Visa or a resident alien.
- submit most recent transcript of all academic work.

ESTIMATED EDUCATION EXPENSES PER YEAR

- submit a completed application which can be found at garagegurus.tech.
- submit two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members.
- submit a typed essay (no more than four (4) pages in length double spaced 1,000 words maximum) or a video (no more than two (2) minutes long) describing "why I want to be a top technician."
